TPSP Limerick engages with young people who become parents when they are under 19 years of age and supports them to build their capacity as parents as well as completing their own development as adolescents moving towards early adulthood. See www.tpsp.ie

Support is offered in all areas of the young person's life - parenting, health, relationships, education, training, childcare, accommodation, social welfare entitlements, legal issues and anything else about which the young person is concerned.

The Teen Parents Support Programme Limerick is delivered through group peer support, one-to-one support and advocacy support. It offers information on a range of issues such as ante-natal and post-natal care, health, child development, accommodation, childcare, welfare rights and entitlements, education and training.

The Teen Parents Support Programme Limerick is a free and confidential service that can be accessed by any young person who is pregnant or who is a parent in Limerick City and County. This Programme is also open to supporting the partner or family of the young person.

How does TPSP Limerick work?

You can contact the TPSP directly or anyone interested in your well-being, or the well-being of your child, may make contact on your behalf.

A project worker will meet you to discuss your needs and concerns and will support you to deal with them as far as possible. You can meet the project worker on your own, as a couple, with a member of your family or with anyone who is supporting you. Meetings may take place in your own home, at the TPSP office or somewhere else where you feel comfortable. You will be supported in a way that best suits your individual needs and the needs of your child. This may be on a one-to-one basis, through group activities or by putting you in contact with other sources of support.



The various supports that can be offered through individual and/or group work include:

- Support with ante natal care and classes
- Information workshops that are tailored to meet the needs and interests of young people
- Opportunity to meet other young parents through various group work programmes
- Parent and child centred activities

- Assistance to remain in or return to education/training
- Grind and education related supports
- Support with childcare
- Support and information for grandparents
